Capacity Building

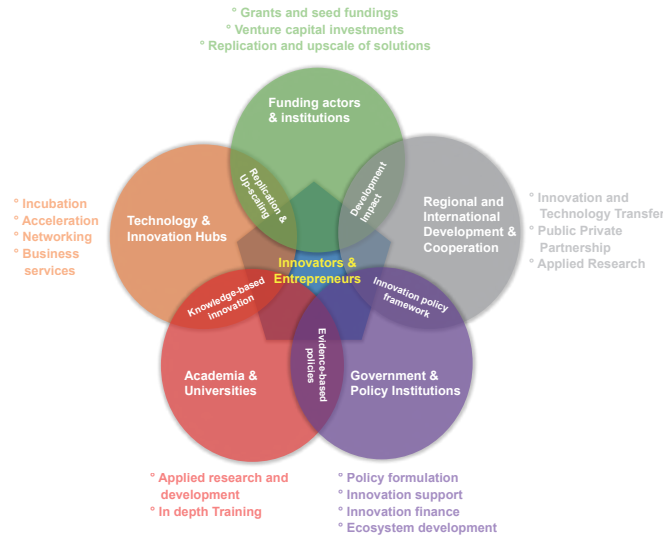

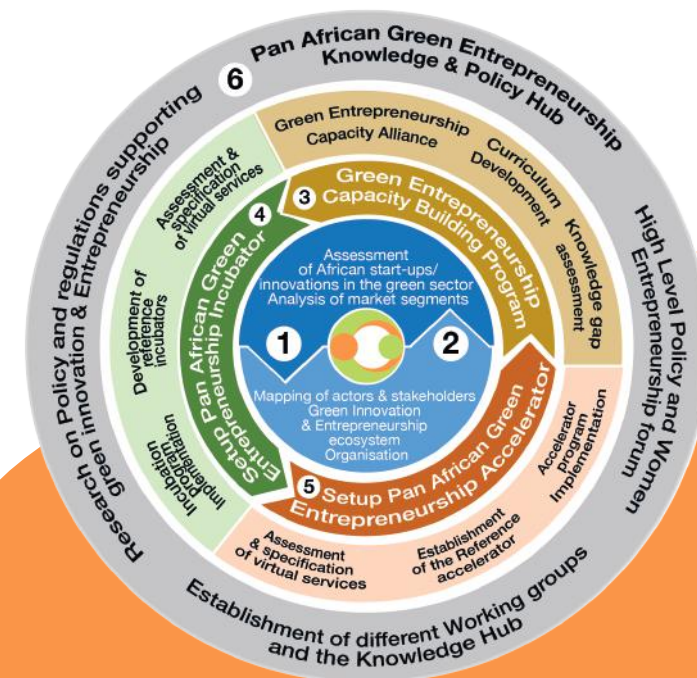

Our Approach to build the Alliance of Innovators and Green Entrepreneurship Stakeholders

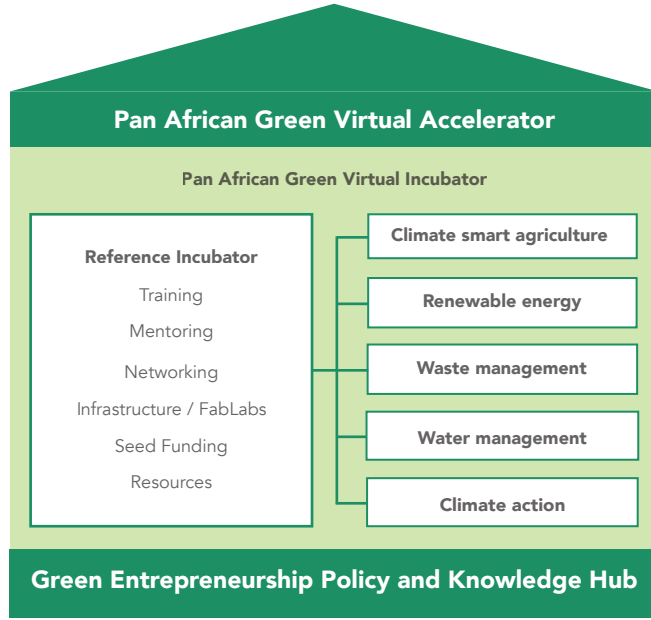


Quintuple Helix of Innovation and Entrepreneurship
